

# 27TH YOUTH CAMP FOR SLOVENIAN CHILDREN FROM ABROAD

CŠOD RAK, CERKNICA, JULY 9 -14, 2023

The Slovenian World Congress will organize 27th Youthcamp for Teenagers of Slovenian Origin from Abroad, from Sunday, July 9, to Friday, July 14, 2023 in CŠOD Rak, close to Cerknica.

The main purpose of the Youthcamp is to bring Slovenia closer to minds and hearts of youngsters who live abroad. Divided into small groups of six teenagers with one group leader/ animator participants discover the beauty of landscapes and various cultural monuments, culture and national identity of Slovenia, learn and improve their use of Slovenian language. Teenagers with no previous knowledge of Slovenian language are also most welcome to attend the camp.

Making new friendships with peers who share a common bond and come from all around the globe is an adventure and a great life experience.

**Attendance fee** per participant is 220 EUR for first applicant, 200 EUR for second and further applicants (valid for family members or group applications) and includes full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner), entrance fees, transportation, workshop materials and accommodation in a youth hostel.
